Northern Virginia Chamber and PSC Names Robotic Research LLC Program of the Year at the 2020 Greater Washington Government Contractor Awards™

Winners Were Announced Live at the 18th Annual Awards Gala (Virtual) on November 4 at 6 p.m. EST

Tysons, VA – Today the [Northern Virginia Chamber of Commerce](#) (Northern Virginia Chamber) and the [Professional Services Council](#) (PSC) have named Robotic Research LLC the Program of the Year during the **18th Annual Greater Washington Government Contractor Awards™** (GovCon Awards), the premier awards event for the Washington area government contracting community.
